life to use hire and enjoy or possess the said negroes Slaves
with the issue thereof as aforesaid in such manner and mode
as to her the said Eliza A Carroll shall seem most advisable
so that the use of the said negroes or the profits of the same
may be applied to the maintenance and support of the said
^{and then Eliza A Carroll for and during the period of her natural life and without any power or authority in the said}
Eliza A Carroll, to alter sell or dispose of the said negroes
or in any manner to pledge or transfer the same and from &
after the death of the said Eliza A Carroll then in trust for

leave surviving her and the use wages or profits of the said ne-

I give and devise unto my daughter Mary Fuller my negro woman named Tyrah with her future issue and increase from the date hereof. Item I give and devise unto my son John my negro slave named Edward with his share and interest in the land called the old mill site. Item I give and devise unto my daughter Emma Magrath my negro slave named Molly with her future issue and increase from the date hereof. Item I give and devise unto my grandchild William Baumgardner my share and interest in the land called the old mill site. Item I give and devise unto my grandchild Emily Hayes my share and interest in the land called the old mill site. Item I give and devise unto my four children John McKell and Emma Magrath each one fifth part of all the rest and residue of my Estate of what kind and of all kinds consisting except such as may be otherwise disposed of by me.

herein direct and desire that inasmuch as certain legal
proceedings are now instituted by which the title to the plan-
tation or tract of land devised to my daughter Mary McKel
now Mary Fuller under the will of her Father Ephraim
McKel is made questionable, and it may be declared that
that the title to the said plantation or tract of land is insuffi-
cient and imperfect. In case therefore that it shall be deemed
and adjudged by the Courts of competent authority that the
title to the said plantation or tract of land is insufficient &
imperfect and the possession thereof be taken from the said
Mary Fuller or her heirs and in case also that it shall
be held and adjudged that there is no recovery over against
the parties from whom the said plantation or tract of land
was purchased, then and in such case I do hereby direct
and devise that the bequests herein before in my said
last will and Testament given to my Children J. McKel
J. C. McKel and Emma C. Magrath and to my grand-
children William Haring and Edward McKel shall
abate so that the said four shares shall constitute

about so that the said four shares shall contribute
in an equal proportion to each of the said shares to make
up the sum of three thousand dollars. And the said sum
of three thousand dollars upon the happening of the events
hereinbefore mentioned I give devise and bequeath unto my
Daughter Mary Fuller absolutely and forever and in case
the said events should not happen or be ascertained before
my death then and in such case I do authorize and empower
my Executor named in my said last will and Testament
to retain from each of the aforesaid four shares such proportion
as will be necessary to make up the said sum of three thousand
dollars and to invest the same in such manner as to him
shall seem advisable and the same to hold until such time
as it shall be made to appear to his satisfaction that the
said sum of three thousand dollars either will or will not
