Item I give and bequeath my Fair Spring Plantation to my son William to him and his heirs for ever, and I give and bequeath unto my son Peter Edmund my Plantation Kickery Hill and the Plantation on the Round O being part of the late David Youngbloods David Youngbloods Plantation, Item I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Finden my Horse Parter, Item it is my Will and desire that no Commiffion be taking for my acting for the Estate of Richard Findin and as soon as my son Thomas Findin comes of age that a division may then take place of said Estate Item I then give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife the Choice of a Negro Girl to her and her heirs for ever. I also give and bequeath at the same time unto my Daughter Elizabeth the choice of Negro Girl to her and her heirs for ever, Item I give and bequeath unto my son William a Negro Boy Cudgo to him and his heirs for ever, Item I give and bequeath unto my son Peter Edmund a Negro Boy Anthoney to him and his heirs for ever, Item I do give my Executrix and Executors full power and authority to sell and dispose of any part parcel or the whole of the residue or ballance of my Lands, Item it is my Will and desire that the whole of the residue of my Estate, real and personal be equally divided between my beloved Wife Mary Youngblood and my three following Children Viz: Elizabeth Youngblood William Youngblood and Peter Edmund Youngblood to them and their heirs for ever, that is to say as soon as my aforesaid Children shall intire Harry or come of Age. Lastly I Consititute and Appoigt my beloved Wife, Mary Youngblood my Executrix and my Friends William Fishburn, Richard Wingilton and Joseph Koger my Executors of this my last Will and Testament In itnefs whereof I have set my Hand and Seal this fifth day of September
