RAYMOND DUPRAT

17-T. } The State of South Carolina. In the Name of God
No. 18. } Amen I Raymond Duprat a native of the Town of Mour-
oux in the department of Iers in the Kingdom of France but
now a resident in the City of Charleston in South Carolina
being some what indisposed in body but of sound mind and
memory do make this my Last Will and testament revoking all
others heretofore by me made & declared first I commit my
Soul into the hands of my redeemer in full hopes of future
Salvation, my body I request my Executors hereinafter named
to have decently buried I will give and bequeath unto my Bro-
ther Vital Duprat now in France all the Real estate which I
have and own in Mouroux in the Kingdom of France for him to
enjoy the Interest and emoluments of said Landed Estate for
and during his natural life and after his decease I then Will
and give the said real Estate unto his children share and share
alike, but it is my will and desire that previous to my said
Brother Vital Duprat taking possession he shall pay unto his
Brother John Duprat and his two Sisters the sum of one hund-
red and fifty francs to each of them which I will and give
them to be paid to them by him as before mentioned I give will
and bequeath unto Ann Duprat a free black woman and her Dau-
ughters Eliza Alias Elizabeth Rachel alias Rebecca Sarah and
Mary all four also free three fifths of the personal Estate
which I may leave at the time of my decease, to them and their
heirs. I give and bequeath unto my God Daughter Mary Capdeville
in this City one half of the two fifths remaining, the other
fifth I desire may be applied to Liquidate a debt due to Louis
Duboug late resident in the Cape at St Domingo, but should it
not be claimed I then direct my Executors hereinafter named to
pay out the said.....

remaining fifth, to pay unto Rachel Alias Rebecca One hundred and fifty Dollars, also unto Sarahs Child named Eliza one hundred and fifty Dollars, I hereby nominate and appoint Joseph Jahan Louis Dubois and Louis Monnar to be my Executors to this my Last Will and testament. In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand & made my Seal at the City of Charleston the tenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty seven.
