the interest annually accruing shall be each year ap-
plied to the purchase of additional Shares to him and
his heirs forever. And I do hereby also nominate and
appoint with their consent J^r P Gadsden Edward &
J^r Edward North to be the Guardians of my said son
Albert during his minority. But should my said son Albert
die before he arrives at an age of discretion sufficient to make
for himself a just disposal of the property herein bequeathed
him, then and in that case I devise and bequeath all
the above mentioned property to my said son Albert

the Building of said House Also nine negroes Slaves
To wit. Granna Morris, Rachael July Charles Sarah
Frank John & Cupid and seven shares in the Rail Road
Bank with the increase thereof. It being my desire that
the interest annually accruing shall be each year ap-
plied to the purchase of additional Shares to him and
his heirs forever. And I do hereby also nominate and
appoint with their Consent G. P. Gadsden Edwards &
G. Edward North to be the Guardians of my said son
Albert during his minority. But should my said son Albert
die before he arrives at an age of discretion sufficient to make
for himself a just disposal of the property herein bequeathed
him, then and in that case I devise and bequeath all
the above mentioned property to my dear Mother Mrs
Frances N. Edwards during the term of her natural life
and as her death I devise and bequeath to Mr Edward
North and to Mr Frederick Porcher my said one half share
in the said House & lot in Lombolt Street together with the
said additional five hundred dollars invested as afo-
resaid and three negro Slaves To wit. John Cupid and
Frank in equal proportions share and share alike
And of the rest and residue of the above mentioned property
I devise and bequeath to G. P. Gadsden Edwards to be taken

care of and to remain as free as the Law will permit
my Servant Dranna during all her life in consideration
for which care as also for whatever expenses may be in-
curred in this behalf I also bequeath them her three Chil-
dren Morris Rachael & July to him and his heirs forever
To my Cousin Meta O Elliott I devise and bequeath
my two Servants Sarah & Charles, and to my Cousins
Catherine O Elliott and Francis M Pinckney I devise
and bequeath the said seven Shares in the Rail Road
Bank with the increase thereof as aforesaid in equal
proportions Share and Share alike In witness whereof
I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal this Twentieth
day of December in the year of our Lord one of
Thousand Eight Hundred and forty five

and failing to have ^{to make effectual disposal thereof and} lawfull issue living at his death
then & in that case I give and devise one half of said
House & Lot to Mrs Edwards North & Mrs Fred^k Forcher
equally between them share and share alike, And
the other half of the said premises to my Mother Mrs
J. B. Edwards absolutely to be at her free disposal to be
disposed of by will or in any other way or manner
whatever. And do hereby revoke & recall the bequest
or provisions of the said will respecting five hundred
Dollars invested in said House & Lot and I do hereby
Confirm & republish the foregoing last will and
Testament Except so far and in such clauses thereof
as are revoked superseded altered and amended.
