of the Parish of St Johns Buckley Planter being by the blessing of Almighty  
God in health of body and perfectly in my Senses but reflecting that Life is  
fleeting and precarious do now make and publish my last Will and  
Testament in manner and form following that is to say my Worldly Es-  
tate with which I have been blessed with after all and Singular my Just  
debts and funeral Expenses are fully paid and Satisfied I do hereby give  
devise and bequeath in manner following Viz. I give & bequeath  
to my beloved Wife Charlotte S Ravenel and to her heirs and assigns  
forever one Seventh part of my Negroes with the future issue and increase  
of the Females she having a right to choose them from among all my Negroes  
after an appraisement is made of my Estate, also the whole of my Plate  
household and Kitchen furniture of every description whatsoever my  
Wariage and hampers my horses, Cattle, Sheep, Hogs and Poultry  
Item I give and devise to my said Wife during her natural life &  
no longer the use occupation and enjoyment of all that part of my  
Plantation called Pooshee lying to the Westwards of the Sauratown Swamp  
and extending Northwardly as far as the Lands of Paul D Ravenel  
and John Moore Item I give devise and bequeath to my Son Henry  
Ravenel his heirs and assigns forever my said Plantation called Pooshee  
(Excepting such part as is hereinbefore devised to my said Wife during her  
natural life) Consisting of the following tracts of land One tract of

Item I give and devise to my said Wife during her natural life &  
no longer the use occupation and Enjoyment of all that part of my  
Plantation called Pooshee lying to the Westwards of the Fountain Swamp  
and extending Northwardly as far as the Lands of Paul & Ravenel  
and John Moore Item I give devise and bequeth to my Son Henry  
Ravenel his heirs and assigns forever my said Plantation called Pooshee  
(excepting such part as is hereinbefore devised to my said Wife during her  
natural life) Consisting of the following tracts of Land One tract of  
Land containing two Hundred and Ninety acres part of it being on  
the West Side of the Santee Canal, one other tract containing One  
thous and acres adjoining the above mentioned tract, One other tract  
to the north of the last mentioned tract purchased of Paul & Ravenel  
containing One Hundred and fifty Seven Acres, One other tract adjoin-  
ing the last mentioned tract containing One Hundred and fifty Acres  
being a part of the Fountain tract purchased of Paul & Ravenel. One  
other tract called Snellards Land containing two hundred and eighty  
three acres. One other tract of Pine Land containing five hundred acres  
purchased of Stephen Ravenel. one other tract of Pine Land containing  
five hundred acres purchased of Robert Ellison a part being on the  
North Side of the Fountain branch, and one other tract of Pine Land  
originally granted for Eight hundred and nineteen acres a part being on

the Eastern Side of the Mungo Ferry Road, also one seventh part of the whole of my  
negroes with the future issue and increase of the females. Item I give devise and bequeath  
to my son John Stephen Ravenel his heirs and assigns forever all my lands comprising  
the Plantations of Littleton and Hopewell also a tract of land I bought of Jacob Sherman  
containing acres also one seventh part of my negroes with the future issue and  
increase of the females. Item I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Susannah  
Maggick Stevens her heirs and assigns forever one seventh part of my negroes  
with the future issue and increase of the females. Item I give devise and bequeath  
to my Daughters Charlotte Ravenel Maria Ravenel and Catharine  
Ravenel their heirs and assigns forever, each one seventh part of the  
Whole of my negroes with the future issue and increase of the females  
each daughter to have such seventh part on the day she arrives of age or  
is married and in case either of my aforesaid Daughters die before they  
arrive of age or are married then and in that case in the event so hap-  
pening I will order and direct that her or their share shall be equally  
divided among my Surviving Daughters. Item it is my Will that such  
of my negroes as I have hitherto given to my said Son Henry Ravenel  
and my said Daughter Susannah Maggick Stevens shall be taken if they  
wish it as a part of their share at an appraisement to be made on the day  
an appraisement is made of my Estate no reference being had to the value  
at the time they were given. Item I Confirm a deed of Gift by me made  
to my Grandson Henry William Ravenel of a negro boy named Harry

at the time they were given. Item I Confess a deed of my  
to my Grandson Henry William Ravenel of a negro boy named Harry  
them in consideration of the faithful Services of my three old negroes named  
Wotto Sapho and Phillis I hereby give them full and full liberty to reside  
on my said Plantation called Goosecreek during their natural lives and  
to receive and enjoy the same wages and Maintenance on the said  
Plantation that they have been heretofore accustomed to receive and I do hereby  
Charge my Executors and Executors hereinafter named or such of them as shall  
qualify with the payment of the Sum of Seven Dollars to each of them annually  
during their lives. Item I do hereby order and direct that my Executors & Executors  
or such of them as shall qualify on this my Will do keep my whole Estate  
together and work the same to the best advantage until all my just & lawful  
debts are paid. And Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint  
my beloved Wife Charlotte I Ravenel my Son Henry Ravenel & John  
Stephen Ravenel my brothers Henry Ravenel Paul D. Ravenel Stephen  
Ravenel and Samuel James Ravenel and my Son in Law Charles Stevens  
Executors and Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all  
former and other Wills and declaring this only to be my last Will & Testament  
In Witness Whereof I the said Rene Ravenel have hereunto set my hand and  
Seal this Eighteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and eighteen

State of South Carolina 1793. In the name of God Amen I  
Francis Ryckbosch of the City of Charleston in the State of South Carolina  
aforesaid Broke being of sound mind memory and understanding  
(praised be God for it) and considering the Certainty of death and the  
uncertainty of the time thereof and to the end I may be the better prepared  
to leave this World whenever it shall please God to call me here  
do therefore make and declare this my last Will and Testament in  
manner following (that is to say) First and principally I recommend  
my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my Creator Hoping for free  
pardon and remission of all my sins and to enjoy everlasting happiness  
in his heavenly Kingdom through the sole merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour  
my body I commit to the earth at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter  
named and as to the worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased  
God in this life to bless me I give the same and dispose thereof as follows  
It is my express will and desire and I do hereby order and direct that my  
Said Executors do and shall with all convenient speed after my decease
