RICHARD BREMAN

17 0⁰ State of South Carolina & City of Charleston. Fourth
 20 40 of May 1824 I R Brennan of State and City aforesaid
 being now in perfect health and in my usual senses do make
 this my Last Will and Testament for the direction of those
 to whom I leave the management of my Estate. After all my
 Lawful Debts are paid from the proceeds of any part of my
 property most convenient to sell for the advantage of my fam-
 ily. I first will & bequeath to my eldest Son Richard Bre-
 man one thousand Dollars, five hundred of which to be paid
 him when he arrives at the age of Twenty one years and the
 other five hundred to be paid him in one year afterwards the
 said one thousand Dollars to be deducted from the portion I
 will to him in this Instrument so as to place all my Children
 on an equal footing. I then will and bequeath my remaining
 property both real & personal and of every description be-
 tween my wife Eliza Brennan and all the children she may have
 alive and bearing by me at the time of my demise in equal
 shares or proportions say share and Share alike and in the
 following manner viz^d to my wife I leave her share without
 control I also leave to her my Childrens Shares while she is
 alive and remains a widow but if she marries again each child
 is to have his or her share as they respectively arrive at ma-
 jority age say twenty one years, and if one or more of my chil-
 dren should die prior to their mothers death or Second mar-
 riage or prior to their own arrival at twenty one years then
 his hers or their shares or share is to go in equal propor-
 tions to their Mother if then alive and a Widow and to the
 surviving Brothers and Sisters of said child or children so
 dying, and under the same regulations as their respective
 Shares was left to them the Interest of my Childrens Shares
 may be appropriated for Maintenance cloaths & Education. I
 nominate & appoint as my Executors my Wife Eliza Brennan and my
 Son Rich^d Brennan as my Executors. In Witness whereof I have

hereunto set my hand & Seal his fourteenth day of May in the year of our Lord 1824. Signed sealed published & declared by the testator as his last Will and testament in the presence of us who in his presence and at his request and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as Witnesses hereunto
