the uncertainty thereof to the end I may be the better
prepared to leave this World whenever it shall please God
to call me hence do therefore make and declare this my
last Will and Testament in Manner & Form following —
That is to say First & principally I commit my Soul into
the hands of Almighty God my Creator Hoping for Grace
pardon and remission of all my sins and to enjoy everlasting
happiness in his heavenly Kingdom through the sole merit
of Jesus Christ my Saviour, my Body I commit to the
Earth at the discretion of my Executors herein after
named As to such Worldly Estate Wherewith it hath
pleased God to intrust me I dispose of the same
as followeth. I Impriem I direct that all my Just
debts and funeral Expenses be first paid.

Then it is my Will & desire and in order that as Speedy
a Settlement of my Estate shall take place as possible and

to call and hence do therefore make and declare this my
last Will and Testament in manner & form following —
That is to say First & principally I commit my Soul into
the hands of Almighty God my Creator Hoping for free
pardon and remission of all my sins and to enjoy everlasting
happiness in his heavenly Kingdoms through the sole merit
of Jesus Christ my Saviour, my Body I commit to the
Earth at the discretion of my Executors herein after

pleased God to interest me I dispose of the same
as followeth. I Imprius I direct that all my Just

to Margaret Shand the Daughter of Robert Shand
Five hundred Dollars, likewise a free Melatto Boy

27th of James son of Nancy Bell a free woman one
thousand Dollars to James & Robert Locky Merchants
in Dundee East Lothian Scotland the residue of my
Property must be transmitted and to be divided by
them share & share alike to the following persons
That is to say to James & Robert Locky my Cousins
Jenny Cameron my Cousin & my half Brothers & Sisters
on my mother's side to them and their Heirs
And lastly I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint
my friends Whiteford Smith Jun^r William Watson and
Robert Maund Executors of this my last Will & Testament
fully revoking & making void all former and other
Wills by me at any times or times heretofore made
declaring this only to be and containing my last will
and Testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this first day of August in the Year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ten
Signed, Sealed, published and declared by the before
named Robert Maund as and for his last Will and
Testament in the presence of us Who at his request in his
