August 8th 1817 Charleston. Dear Brother. This was Mr. Wayport's my
agreement when we went in Copartnership. Mr. William Wayport
was to give me \$216. dollars as I had lost that while establishing
my business I had when I began \$363. dollars after giving Doctor
his share I then had $\frac{363}{216}$ dollars. of this I paid for him, ^{which} at the close
of our business. this is $\frac{575}{564}$ to be the way we will settle our Profits
our expenses will be paid each, and store expenses while at our basing
all other expenses is paid individually should any mistake or death
on either part this shall be for you to bring forwards and prove your
write which I gave all I profess to you should I die without a Will
