and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following viz I will
that all my Just debts and funeral charges be paid of them I give and
bequeath unto my Son Paul twenty Shares in the Planters Mechanicks
Bank and Six Negroes namely Jack & My. Diannah Clarissa Sam
and Josiah and two hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever.
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly twenty Shares in the Plan-
ters and Mechanicks Bank and the following Negroes namely Judith
Rosa Saml Abram Suba and Bob and Two hundred Dollars to
I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth a Girl named Pat
my horse and Sulkie a Bed and Bed furniture also twenty Shares in

the United States Bank. I give and bequeath unto my son George Ten
Shares in the United States Bank and a negro boy named Bob. I give and
bequeath unto my son Nicholas Eighteen Shares in the Planter & Merchants Bank
and one Share in the United States Bank together with my share. I give
and bequeath unto my son Robert a negro fellow named Amos and twenty
Shares in the Planter and Merchants Bank. I give and bequeath unto my
son Arnoldus a negro fellow named Amos and twenty Shares in the Planter
and Merchants Bank. I give and bequeath unto my son Jonah a negro
named Melly and twenty Shares in the Planter & Merchants
Bank. I further give and bequeath unto my sons Nicholas Robert Arnoldus &
Jonah all my Lands to be equally divided between them share & share
alike. I give and bequeath unto my sons Nicholas Robert Arnoldus Jonah
and my Daughter Elizabeth all my Furniture plantation utensils and
stock to be divided equally among them share and share alike. The
rest and residue of my Negroes together with my cash notes and Bonds. I give
and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth and my sons Nicholas Robert
Arnoldus and Jonah to be equally divided among them share and share
alike. I do hereby manumit and set free my Woman Sue and give and
bequeath unto her two hundred Dollars for her Support and Maintenance
I do also manumit and set free two children namely Mark and Sue.
It is also my Will and desire and I do hereby Enjoin it on my Executors herein
after named to manumit and set free John Ned and Rachael as they
shall severally arrive of age. And I do hereby not only fully authorize

after named to manumit and set free John Ned and Rachael as they
shall & legally arrive of age. And I do hereby not only fully authorize
my Executors to carry the above manumitting clause of this Will into effect
by do hereby revoke set aside and declare null and void all and every gift
or Legacy to such of my Sons made as are named Executors to this Will
who shall either neglect or refuse to execute Certificates of Freedom within
twelve months after my death to Sam and his two Children and to John
Ned and Rachael. Within Six months after they shall legally arrive
of age And the Shares and Legacy's so forfeited shall return to the bulk
of my Estate and be Equally divided between my other Children not offending
Share and Share alike. Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my
Brother Nicholas Venning my Sons Nicholas and Robert and my Nephew
Samuel Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
former Wills by me made. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set
my Hand and Seal this second day of May in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred & eighteen - Samuel Venning Junr (L9)

 follows: First I will order and direct that so much of the real or personal
 Estate as I hold under conveyance from my late mother in trust to dispose
 of the same by will or otherwise at my direction for the Benefit of all
 or any of my Children be sold and disposed of by my Executor herein
 after named either at publick or private sale at such time or times, in
 such place or places and on such terms and conditions as he in his
 discretion may deem most advisable and on effecting such sale or sales
 to Execute and deliver to the Purchaser or Purchasers good & sufficient
 deeds and Titles. the said sale to be extended until my said Executor shall
 have raised or secured on account thereof a sum equal to the discharge
 of what may be due on my acknowledgment securing an annuity to
 my said Mother
