Sarah Oshell the sum of Eight hundred dollars unto my revered Father
Micah Orcutt Senior the sum of Five hundred dollars unto my brother
John Orcutt the sum of Five hundred dollars unto my Brother Micah
Orcutt Junior the sum of Three hundred dollars unto my Brother Daniel
Orcutt the sum of Three hundred dollars and unto each and every of
my Six Sisters the sum of Two hundred dollars. Item I give & bequeath
unto Alexander Black. the partner in trade and most confidential and
bosom friend of my dear deceased Husbands the sum of Sixteen hundred
Dollars as a small compensation for his former services to my husband
and for his more than brotherly kindness and attention to me since my
affliction. Item so far as I have the power to do so I constitute and appoint
the said Alexander Black and my friends Philip Robinson or either of
them the Guardians of the person and fortune of my dear son Joseph Hen-
ry Foster. and I earnestly hope that the Court of Equity or any other
court of competent authority will ratify and confirm this appointment
and on condition that the said Philip Robinson accept this appointment
and procure its ratification by the competent court or courts within one
year after my death then I give and bequeath unto him the said Philip
Robinson the sum of Four hundred Dollars but should he decline
to accept this appointment or fail to procure its ratification for one

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When after my death then I revoke the said Legacy of Four hundred dollars
and give and bequeath the said Four hundred Dollars unto the said Alexander
Black in addition to the Legacy herein before given to him. Item I give
and devise all the rest and residue of my Estate real and personal after the
payment of my debts and Legacies as aforesaid unto my Executors hereinafter
named to be Equally divided among them I have and I have alike and I do
hereby Expressly Charge and bind all the property real and personal of which
I may die possessed with the payment of all and singular the above mentioned
Legacies and I authorize and empower my Executors or the Survivor or Sur-
vivors of them or such of them as qualify and act under this Will to Sell &
dispose of all my Estate real and personal at public or at private Sale for
Cash or on credit as may be thought most advantageous and to execute
and deliver good and sufficient Titles therefore and for every part thereof
Lastly I constitute nominate and appoint the said Alexander Black &
my Friends George Hoffman and James R. Schuck Executors of this my
Last Will and Testament revoking and annulling all former and other
Wills by me heretofore made and ratifying and confirming this and no other
to be my last Will and Testament, and I Specially recommend my
beloved Child Joseph H Foster to the care and protection of my good
Friends the said Alexander Black and entreat him by his regard for my
dear Husband and my self to protect our child and to give him as good
an Education as circumstances will permit and to act a Brother's part by
him and to be with implicit confidence on his tried friendship for the
