funeral expenses & charges against my Estate be paid. Secondly
I give devise and bequeath all my Estate real & personal as follows
that is to say I give devise & bequeath the rents issues profits and
income thereof to and for the sole and separate use benefit
& behoof of my Grand-daughter Elizabeth Clifford Lewis

during her natural life nor subject to the debts contracts
engagements or control of any person or persons with whom
she may intermarry: and from and immediately after her
death then I give devise and bequeath the said property
real & personal to the Child or Children of my said Grand-
daughter living at the time of her death to be equally di-
vided between them Share and Share alike if more than
one and if but one then to that one absolutely. The issue
of a deceased Child or Children to represent and take the
share or shares of the parent or parents: but in case the
said Elizabeth Clifford Lewis shall leave no Child
or Children or issue of a deceased Child or Children
living at the time of her death then from and immediately
after her death I give devise and bequeath one half of the
said real & personal Estate to her husband if she shall
leave one living at the time of her death and the other half
to my right heirs and if she shall leave no husband so
living the whole to my right heirs. Thirdly. I hereby
empower my Executor hereinafter named to sell or dispose
of all or any part of my real & personal Estate if deemed
beneficial to those interested under my will and invest
the proceeds in other property subject to the uses & trusts
hereinbefore declared and the dispositions hereinbefore
