Children their heirs and assigns for ever. And I moreover give
and bequeath to the aforesaid Solomon Legare, all the sums of mo-
ney, which I shall be possessed of at the time of my death, or
which may be owing to me. And I hereby appoint the said
Solomon Legare and Sarah his Wife Executrix of this my last
Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my mark this fifteenth day of April in the Year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and one.

48. In the Name of God Amen, I Sarah Hopton of
Charleston in the State aforesaid Widow do make and publish
this to be my last Will and Testament in manner following, first
I give and devise all that my lot of land situate in Meeting and
Pearl Streets in Charleston aforesaid together with all the houses
and improvements thereon at present rented by C W^{rs} Brown and
M^r Samuel Smith, unto my grand Son William Hopton Powell,
and to my two grand daughters Alicia Hopton Russell and Sarah
Russel and to my great grand daughter Alicia Hopton Chichester
to be by them held as tenants in common and not as joint ten-
ants. And my Will and desire is that the share of my said great
grand daughter Alicia Hopton Chichester shall be held in trust
for her by my executrices hereafter named until she shall arrive
at the age of eighteen years, and in case of her death before she
shall have attained the said age, then my will is that her said share
shall be vested in, and held by my said Executrices in trust, for
such other Child as my grand daughter Mary Beatrice Chiche-
ster may hereafter have within that term, and for default of such
other issue then I give and devise the same to my said grand
daughter Mary Beatrice Chichester for and during her

life and from and immediately after her decease without issue
them to my surviving grand children and their heirs respectively
for ever. Also I desire that the rents and profits of the said lot houses
and improvements shall be received and appropriated by my
said Executrices to the payment of all my just debts and
of the legacies hereafter mentioned, the remainder to be by them
disposed of in such manner as they shall think most advanta-
geous for the interests of my devisees, until my said grandson
William Slopton Powell shall attain the age of twenty five
years, and so soon as he shall arrive at that age I desire the
said lot and buildings to be divided into four equal parts, and
that each of my devisees according to the above contingencies receive
their respective shares to them and their heirs for ever, but in
case my said Executrices should be of opinion, in order to pre-
vent disputes, or for a more equitable division of the aforesaid
property, that a sale thereof should take place, I do hereby
authorize and empower them to grant, bargain and sell
the same to any person or persons and their heirs for ever
in fee simple; the proceeds of such sale and profits to be divided, and
the share of my said great granddaughter Alicia Slopton Chiche-
ster, to be held in the same manner and to and for the same
purposes, as the land is above directed to be. And I do hereby further
authorize my Executrices to make use of and employ the profits ar-
ising from said land, or money for the use of my said great grand
child, provided the sum so expended does not exceed one moiety of the afo-
resaid share, the other moiety I desire to be added to the principal, and that
my said Executrices do keep regular accounts thereof. Also I give and
bequeath to my grand daughter Mary Beatrix Chichester three
negro slaves viz. Juno, a Holly and Lucy and in lieu of three other
negroes which I have sold viz. Brutus, a Nancy and Luna I give
to my said grand daughter two bonds viz. Robert Given and
Alexander Cranford's bond conditioned for eighty pounds, and Ben-
jamin Bayly's bond for seventy five pounds, but in case my said
grand daughter Mary Beatrix Chichester should die not leaving
I give them said negroes and bonds to be divided between my grand
daughters Alicia Slopton Pufall and Sarah Pufall. Also I give
to my niece Anna Maria Maryland one hundred guineas to be paid
her in six months after my decease. Also I give to John Legare Son
of Samuel Legare deceased, one hundred guineas to be at the disposal
of his Mother M^r Bonneau as she shall judge best for his advan-

Also I give to Mr. Nathaniel Russell in acknowledgement of my
friendship my negro man Cain. Also to my daughter c Mary Christiana
Gregory, in consideration and view of her having no part of
my landed property, I give and bequeath my three negro men, Pa-
trol and Marks. Also in Testimony of my esteem I give to each of
my friends Ann Smith Widon; c Margaret Hudson and Eliza-
beth Power an annuity of ten pounds per annum during their
respective lives. Also I give and bequeath to my Executrices in trust
and to and for such charitable uses as they shall think proper, a
bond of Abraham Seaver for four hundred pounds. And finally I
give devise and bequeath all the rest residue and remainder of my
Estate both real and personal not herein before otherwise effectually
disposed of unto my daughters c Mary Christiana Gregory
and Sarah Russell and to their heirs respectively forever and
I do nominate and appoint my said daughters c Mary Christiana
Gregory and Sarah Russell Executrices of this my last
Will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all other
Wills by me heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this fifth day of March in the Year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and in the
Twenty third of American Independence.
