Johnny, Abram, Will, Casar, London, Nancy and her child
George, Rachel and her child Sylvia, Ubery and Phil
and their future Issue to her and her heirs for ever.
I do give and bequeath unto my said daughter Susanna
Wilson all the rest of my Estate of what ever na-
ture it may consist to her and her heirs for ever and
I do hereby appoint my daughter Susanna Wilson
Executrix to this my last Will and Testament in
Witness whereof I hereunto subscribe my name
this eight day of February 1791.
