The State of South Carolina. I State Dist. do hereby make and declare the following to be my last Will and Testament whereby I revoke all former Wills and Testaments by me hitherto made. after all my just debts and fully paid I give devise and bequeath one third part of my real and personal Estate to my beloved Wife Sarah Brandford Dist her heirs Executors Administrators & assigns forever, and I also give her all my household furniture at my Country and Town residences, my horses and Carriage absolutely and forever. All the rest and residue of my Estate (with the Exception of the Specific legacies hereinafter specified) I give devise and bequeath to my two Daughters Mary Dist & Elizabeth Packer Dist Shan and Shan alike when they shall respectively attain the age of twenty one years, to them their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever. Should either of my said Daughters depart this life before she attains the age of twenty leaving issue living at the time of her death it is my will that the share to which she would have been entitled at her coming of age should go to the said child or children their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever. Should either of my said Daughters die under the said age without leaving issue I then give and bequeath her portion to her surviving Sister at the time of her arriving of age her heirs and Executors and assigns forever. And I should both of my said Daughters die under the said age and without issue (as I intend their issue in every respect to represent them)

then I give and bequeath their portions to my beloved Wife Sarah to have
 for and during the term of her natural life and after her death to the
 Children of my sister Lydia Calhoun and (Pursuant to the
 consent of their parents) Shaw and Shaw alike their heirs Executors Admin-
 istrators and assigns forever. I give and bequeath to my God Son States
 Bist Deas my Gold Watch and chain and my full blooded Son
 Man Anna, also my horses Crickett, Federalist and Mr Henry, and all
 the rest of my horses to my Brother William Battell. I hereby nominate
 constitute and appoint my Brother William Battell and my friends
 Thomas W Burt Henry W Burt Thomas W Deas & Thomas
 Atkin Executors of this my Will. Witness my hand and Seal this
 day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty two

In Trust for my Godson Robert McKinnon Haig his heirs and assigns forever on his attaining the age of twenty ~~one~~ and in default thereof, then in trust for each of my Children as may then be living the said Sum of \$200 to be placed at Interest by my Executors and paid from my Estate generally as soon as they shall find convenient after payment of all just debts it is also my Will and desire that my said Executors do cause a suitable plain monument or Tomb Stone to be erected in St Michael's Cemetery to the memory of my Father my Sister and myself when they shall find convenient from the income of my Estate.
