this instrument of writing to be my last will and Testament
in manner and form following That is to say In the first
place I will and direct that all my just debts and
funeral expenses be paid after my decease as soon
as may be convenient, and touching my worldly Estate
I will devise and bequeath as follows I give and bequeath
to my Grand daughter Susan Eliza Gaillard and her assigns
John Eliza Harris's Bond for three thousand dollars with
whatever interest may be due thereon at the time of my death
also William Gibbs's Bond for Eleven hundred dollars with
the interest due thereon at the time of my death: also one
third part of all the Bank Stock and ready money I may
be possessed of at the time of my death also my new half
set of Dravos. In the second place I give and bequeath
to my Great Grandson Daniel Hall Gaillard and
his assigns forever Ford & Pringle's Bond for Two thousand
Two hundred dollars with the interest that may be due
thereon at my death also my negro boy named Quibus
also my large Bedstead all the bedding attached to the same
to him and his assigns forever for the time of his life

Two Hundred dollars with the interest that may be due
thereon at my death also my negro boy named Oribus
also my large Bedstead all the bedding attached to the same
to him and this apportion forever In the third place I give
and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza Maria Couturier
Thomas J. Gantt's Two Bonds for one Thousand dollars
each with all the interest that may be due thereon at
the time of my death In the fourth place I give and
bequeath to my daughter Anna Thompson and her assigns
forever William Riley's bonds for Two Thousand dollars with
all the interest that may be due thereon at my death. I
also give unto my eldest daughter Anna Thompson my
large Wardrobe. In the fourth place I give all my
Household Furniture to be equally divided between
my daughter Anna Thompson and my grand daughter
Susan E. Gaillard. The rest and residue of my Estate
which may be at my disposal say the remaining
Two Thirds of my Bank Stock and all the other bonds
Mortgages Obligations and money I may die possessed of
I give and bequeath to my two daughters Anna Thompson
and Eliza Maria Couturier to be equally divided be-
tween them share & share alike. And Lastly I do
hereby nominate constitute and appoint my two
Daughters Eliza M. Couturier & Anna Thompson and

my Grand daughter Susan E. Gaillard, Executrix and my
Grand Grandson Daniel Hall Gaillard, Executor of this
my last will and Testament hereby revoking and declaring null
and void all or any former wills or wills by me heretofore
at any time made. In witness whereof I the said Susanna
Hall have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
this twenty third day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and forty four
