I will devise and bequeath as follows I give and bequeath

Phelis Morris's Bond for three thousand dollars with  
whatever interest may be due thereon at the time of my death  
also Wilmer Gibbs Bond for Eleven hundred dollars with  
the interest due thereon at the time of my death: also one  
third part of all the Bank Stock and ready money I may  
be possessed of at the time of my death also my new half  
set of Dravos. In the Second place I give and bequeath  
my Great Grand son Daniel Hall Gaillard and  
his assigns forever Ford & Priseau's Bond for Two Thousand  
Two Hundred dollars with the interest that maybe due  
thereon at my death also my negro boy named Quibus  
also my large Bedstead all the bedding attached to the same  
to him and his assigns forever In Testimony whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand this 1st day of October in the year of our Lord

Two hundred dollars with the interest that may be due  
thereon at my death also my negro boy named Tribus  
also my large Bedstead all the bedding attached to the same  
to him and this apnys forever In The Third place I give  
and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza Maria Foutier  
Thomas J Gant's two Bonds for one thousand dollars  
each with all the interest that may be due thereon at  
the time of my death In The fourth place I give and  
bequeath to my daughter Anna Thompson and her apnys  
forever William Riley's bond for two thousand dollars with  
all the interest that may be due thereon at my death I  
als give unto my daile daughter Anna Thompson my  
large Wardrobe In the fourth place I give all my  
Household Furniture to be equally divided between  
my daughter Anna Thompson and my grand daughter  
Elizan E Gaillard. The rest and residue of my Estate  
which may be at my disposal say the remaining  
Two thirds of my Bank Stock and all the other bonds  
Mortgages obligations and money I may die possessed of  
I give and bequeath to my two daughters Anna Thompson  
and Eliza Maria Foutier to be equally divided be-  
tween them share & share alike And Lastly I do  
hereby nominate constitute and appoint my two  
Daughters Eliza M Foutier & Anna Thompson and

my grand daughter Susanna Hall Gaillard, Executing witness  
Elizabeth Chapman & Daniel Hall Gaillard Executors of this  
my last will and testament having recd my said last will and  
testament and void all or any former wills or wills by me theretofore  
at any time made also witness whereof I the said Susanna Hall  
Hall have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal  
this twenty third day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand  
Eight hundred and forty four
