I Susannah Bollins of St. Thomas parish in the State of South Carolina being sick and weak in body, but of sound and disposing mind, do publish and declare this to be my last Will having revoked all other Will or Wills by me at any time heretofore made. To wit first of all my Will is that my Executor or Executrix herein named do (after my death) have my body decently buried without any unnecessary expense; Item I give unto my daughter Charlotte Boon the whole of the money which I have now in my possession (say three hundred and twenty dollars) for the purpose of purchasing a negro girl for her use as a servant or slave during her lifetime; after her death I give the said negro girl unto my grand daughter named Susannah Batey. Item I also give unto my said daughter Charlotte Boon, three silver table spoons, ^{fourteen silver tea spoons,} also one Silver cup or mug. Item I give unto my Son Jonathan Bollins three silver Table Spoons and three silver tea spoons, also one silver cup; Item I give unto my Son Robert Bollins two cows and two calves and to his daughter

Charlotte, one heifer calf Item I give unto my grand daughter Charlotte
Collins, one heifer calf, the remainder of my cattle it is my
will that they be equally divided between my descendants Collins
and my Daughter Charlotte Boon, Item I give unto my son Jonathan
Collins the chest of Drawers which I now have in my possession
now. Item I give unto my grand daughter Charlotte Collins, daugh-
ter of my Son Robert my Feather bed, and lastly I do nominate
and appoint my Son Jonathan Collins and my daughter Char-
lotte Boon Executor and Executrix to this my Will. X (R)
