In the Name of God Amen, I Susannah Postell of Charleston in the State of South Carolina Widow, being of sound mind and perfect memory and willing to settle my worldly affairs, have made this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking disannulling and making void all former and other Wills by me made, at any time heretofore, and do appoint and ordain this ^{to be} my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say, I desire that all my just debts be paid and satisfied as soon as possible after my decease. I give and bequeath unto my loving daughter Ann Waring three certificates or indents in my name of the funded debt of the United States, amounting in the whole to three hundred and fifty dollars ⁴⁰⁰ viz one numbered 562 for 159 dollars ⁴⁰⁰, and one other numbered 393 for 56 dollars ⁴⁰⁰ both bearing the interest of six per centum per annum and one num

69. beared 393 for 119 dollars $\frac{46}{100}$ bearing the interest of three per centum per Annum, and also one other certificate or indent being the deferred debt of the State of South Carolina numbered 349 for fifty six dollars $\frac{40}{100}$ to her and her heirs for ever. Item It is my Will and desire that all the rest and remaining part of my Estate real and personal be equally divided six months after my decease, between my loving Son Thomas Waring and my loving daughters Mary Waring, Edith Waring and Ann Waring share and Share alike to them and their heirs for ever. And lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my aforesaid Son Thomas Waring and my Son in law Morton Waring Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I the said Susannah Postell have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six.
