the hands of my Executors after payment of debts due from
my Estate. I give devise and bequeath the rest and residue
of my Estate after payment of all my just debts, ^{and the debts} which I
may owe as administrator of the Estates of my late honored
father Thomas Trink and mother Rebecca E. Trink, consisting

148. of Arthur and lot No forty four ⁱⁿ Pinckney Street and sundry
Houses, to wit, Myself, Lucy and her two children Jane and
Elizabeth, Jimmy, Lucetta, Maria, Sarah, and her seven

at the time of my death, together with such debts due and
