the St. Patrick's Benevolent Society ^{of Charleston} One hundred Dollars.
I give devise and bequeath unto my friend Laurence M. Dawson
my gold watch, chain, seals and key. I give devise and bequeath
unto my wife Grace the negro girl Charlotte, together with the entire
residuary of my Estate after the payment of the above mentioned

Legacies, to him, his heirs and assigns forever. And lastly I do hereby
nominate constitute and appoint my wife Grace Executor and
Laurens W. Dawson Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
