No. 13. 1^o It is my wish that all my just and legal debts shall be paid before my Estate
is divided. 2^o I give and Bequeath unto my Brother Sam'l Palmer my Plantation
called the oaks as resurveyed and divided by Mr David Gaillard in conformity
to the last Will and Testament of my Father, with the household furniture
Beds &c to him and his heirs forever. 3^o I give and bequeath to my Mother Mrs
H. Palmer my Plantation called Job Bridge during the continuance of her partial
or permanent residence in this Village, In case of her return removal to said
Village I give and Bequeath the said Plantation to my Brother Sam'l Palmer
to him and his heirs forever. 4^o To my friend Charles Evans the Captain
of my tract of Land (about one thousand acres) commonly called the Junction
Farm I give to him and his heirs forever. 5^o To my dear friend James
Edmonson I request the acceptance of Three Hundred Dollars to purchase of
Watch or Drills Brassed Gun (as may think fit) or other articles desired

Shipwrecked. On whatever property I may die disposessed of, I desire may be
 equally divided among my Brothers Edward G Palmer John S Palmer
 Sam'l G Palmer and my Sister Marianne Gaillard. to my Brothers
 and their heirs if any. To my Sister and the heirs of her Body, if any.
 It is my wish however that my Sister Should take Billy's (carpenter) family
 inclusion in her proportion at the division. If it should happen my Brothers
 die before they may arrive to the age of twenty one, to have issue, the
 Juniors with my Sister or the Heirs of her Body Shall Share and Share
 alike. 8th I hereby nominate and appoint my respected friends James
 & German Stephen G Duncan Tho. Gaillard and my Brother C G Palmer
 Executors to this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof

Marianne Gaillard. 2^o It is my desire that my Brother Sam'l D Palmer
Shall at the division take 1 Blacksmith I am his wife & Children
Subject to the same restrictions as my Sister in the bequest of Billy and his
Family, that is to say they are to be included in their respective equal portions.
