to be my last will and Testament First I bequeath my
body to the dust from whence it came and commend my
soul to my Creator who gave it Secondly In consider-
ation of the loves and affection that I have experienced
at the hands of my mother that bore me I hereby bequeath
and leave unto her or in the event of her having died
unto her heirs all my property goods chattels and effects
or moneys that may belong to me after my body having
been decently buried and all my just debts paid. And
to carry my views in this my last will and Testament
in Effect I constitute and appoint Cord Dieckhoff
of Charleston Neck & Henry Hudaff of the City of
Charleston my Executors declaring my previous wills
void In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal at Charleston S.C. the 11th of September 1845
