Know all men by these presents that I Coll: William Sayle
Governor of that part of the Province of Carolina Southward and
Westward from Cape Carterett otherwise called Cape Roman
for and on behalfe of the Lords Proprietors of the said Province
of Carolina having made my last will and testament in Bermuda
bearing date in the month of february last past w^{ch} said will I
doe by this present Codicill ratifye and confirme NOW being
in body but (blessed be God) in perfect mind and memory (for the
full disposall of all my goods and chattels lands and tenements
disposed of in the s^d Will) I doe hereby give devise and bequeath
all that my Mansion house and Towne lott in Albemarle poynt
in the said Province of Carolina to my eldest Sonne Nathaniel
Sayle and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten and to be begotten
forever. Item I doe give devise and bequeath all my other lands
and tenements goods & chattels w^{ch} shall be in my possession at the time
of my decease in the s^d Province and all the lands perquisites or
advantages due to me in the said Province of Carolina or any part
thereof by virtue of the concessions of the said Lords Prop^rs or
otherwise unto my two Sonnes Nathaniel Sayle and James Sayle
and the heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten and to be begotten
forever. And my will and pleasure is that the Codicill or Schedule
be and be adjudged and taken to be a part of my last will and testa-
ment afores^d and to be of equall force wth the same. And I hearti-
ly desire and require mine Execut^r and Overseers of the Executors
of my said last will that they doe cause all things in this Schedule or
Codicill contained to be faithfully performed according to my true
meaning as if the same were so declared in my said last will

To all Christian People to whom these presents shall come
I Henry Woodward now resident at Ashley River
Province of Carolina being now resolved a Journey to the
of the said river and in respect same may prove hazardous
dangerous I doe make this my last will & testament in forme
Imprimis. I give and bequeath what lands or tenements properly
me the s^d Henry Woodward as one of the first settlers to the heart
s^d John Yeaman Barst he and his heirs. Item. What lands
goods may or shall arrive in my behalfe either from the s^d Proprietors
any of my relations to the abovesaid s^d John Yeaman Barst. And
until such time as the certainty of my death or returne be knowne
I doe constitute and appoynt the abovesaid s^d John Yeaman Barst
my true and lawfull Attorney to receive and take whatsoever goods
may or shall arrive in my behalfe in the aboves^d Province in
name and for my use as if I were my selfe present. And all that
he shall doe herein I doe ratifye and confirme. Witness my
hand and seal. Jul: 17th 1671.
