 which shall belong to her of my Estate in Carolina & her during
 her natural Life or time of Widowhood and after her Decease
 Marriage then to be equally divided between my two Daughters Mary
 & Martha Johns & still to the said Mary & Martha their heirs &
 Assigns for ever.

Lastly I Do constitute my Beloved wife Francis Johns Executrix
 of my Will & my Executors to be John Gardiner Esq^r George Josias Esq^r John
 Smith Esq^r Executors to the said Will And I bequeath my Brother
 Jeremiah Johns Deceased his Love in my hand & twenty Pounds
 to be paid out of my Estate in Carolina before divided as follows
 Ten Pounds to his wife Mary Johns five Pounds to his own Mother
 Elizabeth Johns & five Pounds to his Mother in Law Mrs. M^{rs} M^{rs} M^{rs}
 which I Under these my two Executors residing in Carolina to
 send the Money home In Witness whereof I have signed
