 Cause to be made a true & faithful Inventory & appraisment of all & his
 Chattels Rights & Credits of y^e said Deceased as far as they shall have come
 & truly & faithfully appraised by three sufficient freeholders upon the
 same under their hands return into y^e Secretarys Office within ninety
 dayes of y^e Administrat^r do well & truly satisfy & pay all y^e
 Debts so far as y^e Estate shall amount unto & y^e Law binds him &
 bind his Heirs & all other persons whatsoever as an Administrat^r ought
 bind him & that y^e Administrat^r do render an Acc^t of his doings
