 In the name of God Amen I Katherine Rowland
 of Bartley County in the Province of South Carolina being in a weak
 and low condition of body yett of sound and perfect mind and memory
 Praised be Almighty God do make and ordain this my last will and
 testament recommending my soul into the hands of my Creator hoping
 through the merits death and passion of my blessed saviour Jesus Christ
 to have full and free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins and to inherit
 eternall life. my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a decent man-
 -ner and attending my worldly estate which Almighty God hath bene
 pleased to bestow upon me I doe give and bestow as followeth.
 I give I will that all my debts and financial charges be paid and discharged
 I give I give and bequeath unto John Porter four choice good cows and
 calves and twenty pounds currency amongst his children to be paid and
 delivered to him in such time after my decease by my Executors hereafter
 named. I give I give and bequeath unto John Bindens eldest
 daughter two cows and calves I do late bequeath by my late hereafter
 named. I give I give and bequeath unto William Sterlings son
 George Sterlings name two cows and calves to be delivered in that time
 being Spring by me to be hereafter named. I give I give will is that
 John Porter and John Bindens daughter have their cattle at the same
 time as George Sterlings receive his. I give I give and bequeath unto
 my son Richard Herdson ten pounds currency money to be paid unto
 him by my Exrs hereafter named for to purchase a suit of mourning.
 I give I give and bequeath unto my love Grandsons John Herdson
 and Francis Herdson all my real estate to be equally divided between
 the said John and Francis when they shall come to the age of twenty
 one years each. I give I give and bequeath unto the said John
 and Francis the remainder and residue of my personal estate
 to be equally divided between them at the age of twenty one.
 I give I give will is that if either of my aforesaid Grandsons shall
 dye before they come to of age after twenty one year or without issue lawfull
 begotten then the survivor shall inherit my whole estate both real
 and personal. Finally I recommende constitute and appoint the
 Dea. John Ep. McDaniel Rector and the Rev. Samuel (all
 of this same County and Province aforesaid) Executors of my last will
 and testament hereby annulling and breaking all other wills with
 void that have been heretofore by me made. In witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand and Seal this sixth day of February in
 the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and twenty six
