Each of whiche to have an annuity due to thame of thre hundred poundes to be paid to them by my executors or by my wife in Barbados therer and, according to me the number of £300 in my succeeding opportunity to remitt or remise to thame in Barbados with me by land or sea to be paid to them as soon as convenient & my deare wife due to them as soon as convenient as may be at thame place as above mentioned. In such sorte you will see fit to make out & pay to them as above mentioned as soon as convenient & as above mentioned. In witness whereof I have setto my hand this day 1st day of May 1703.
