debts and duties that I owe in conscience or justice to any Person or persons
whatsoever be well & truly satisfied & contented & paid in some conve-
nient time after my decease by my Executors after named. Secondly
I give & bequeath all my Estate Real and Personall to my well beloved
wife Elizabeth Jones my sons Francis Jones & Phillipp Jones & my daughters
Lucy Mary, Elizabeth Sarah & Ann Jones to be divided equally between
my said wife & children & Ann Jones to be divided to my said children when they
come to age today when Francis & Phillipp Jones are one & twenty years
of age & my said children are of y^e age of fifteen years or are married & if
I do happen that either my wife or children expire this life before they
come to age or are married that then my said Estate be divided
between

between the survivors equally & that my estate remaine the in y^e person
to occupation of my said wife whom I make & appoint to be executor
of this my last will & testament during my childrens minority In
