No 2 The last will & testament of George Crichton Bundles 1 to 2.
In the Name of God Amen the twenty seventh day of August
in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & fourteenth
I Geo. Crichton of Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina
Singles being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & sense
my thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind
the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for
all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & testament
That is to say principally first of all I give & recommend my soul
unto the hands of God who gave it & my body I recommend to the
Earth to be buried in decent Christian manner at the discretion
of my Ex^{ors} without doubting but at the general resurrection I shall
receive the same again by the Almighty power of God & as
concerning such worldly estate whereunto it hath pleased God to
bless me in this life I give & devise & dispose of the same in the
following manner & form. I purp^{ose}. I give & bequeath to Eliza-
beth Crichton my dearly beloved wife one third part of all my personal
& removable estate to her & her heirs forever. Item. I give to
my said beloved wife one Indian Boy named Arde tone
Indian girl named Sam together with a clay plate bearing
her or any other relations names as also one bay mare
formerly belonging to herself wth all the produce of said mare
they both redime herse to her & her heirs forever. Item. I give
unto my well beloved daughter Ann Crichton two hundred
pounds current money of this Province to be paid out of my
said Estate by my said Wife on the day of her marriage or at
the age of eighteen wth shall first happen with one neg^ro boy
named Titus one black mare & colt wth their produce to her &
her heirs forever. Item. I will & appoint that my said daughter
Ann Crichton be maintained & educated out of the produce of
my ^{said} Estate as decently & handsomely as the same will permit until
she be married or that she arrive at the said age of eighteen years
wth shall first happen. Item. I give to my well beloved daughter
Eliza Crichton an equal share of the remaining part of my moveable
& personal Estate with her brother George Crichton the same to
be paid & delivered her at the day of marriage or at the age of one
twenty wth shall first happen the wth I give to her & her heirs
forever. Item. I will that all my children & my said wife
