Master on board his Majesties the Fort Captain Thomas Arnold Commander
And I do hereby nominate and appoint the said Christian Scarles full and
sole Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all
former wills by me made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal the twentieth day of July Anno Dom 1729
