deputation from the Rev<sup>n</sup> Mr Arthur Middleton Esq President & dated the thirteenth  
and twentyeth day of September anno Dom 1729 to administer the proper oaths to the  
Witnesses and Executors to the last will and testament of David McConnell  
late of Saint Johns Parish in this Province deceased. This is therefore to certify  
that on the first day of October 1729 I did examine & administer the proper oaths to  
James Wright George Forman and James Farrell as witnesses to the said Will  
and Edward Ireton one of the Executors therein named.

Given under my hand and seal this first day of October anno domini 1799.

Master on board his Majesties the Top Captain Thomas Arnold Commander  
and I do hereby nominate and appoint the said Christian Stearns full and  
sole Executrix of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all  
former wills by me made Testitress whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand and seal the twentyeth seventh day of July anno Dom 1729
