Roger Player

In the Name of God Amen. The twenty fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven the fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George by the Grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c. Roger Player in Christ Church Parish in the County of South Down County United Kingdom sick and weak in body both of sound and of good mind and memory (thanks be to God for the same) and being aware of the uncertainty of this transitory life on Earth and being desirous to settle things in order to make certain publish and declare this to be my last will & testament & to make good by these presents all things therein & former will and Wills testament & by me heretofore made declared either by word or writing & this only to be taken for my last will and testament and none other.

I do commend myself to God my Creator & Redeemer & in my body named shall be thought fit convenient and so in the settling my temporal estate such goods chattels debts as it hath pleased God for about my debts to bestow upon me. No ordinary bequest & disposal of the same in manner & forme following (that is to say) I do give & bequeath I will that all debts due or owing to or by me I justly owe or ordered to be paid within convenient time after my decease by Roger Player or his heirs or assigns with one half of the stock bequeaths therein except one negro boy named Coplan w^{ch} I give & bequeath to my loving son The^{rs} Player with the other half part of my plantation stock bequeaths to be equally divided between my son

Thos comes to the age of twenty one years. Item I do give & bequeath that my son Roger should continue on the plantation at the use of all the slaves & stock excepting the negro man Lewis who is to be hired out on Farm by my Executors my said son Roger being accountable to my Executors yearly for his full share of profits thereof w^{ch} shall be towards the maintenance of my son Thomas. Item I desire that Eliza^h Cornish may live in the house as she now lives in on the plantation aforesaid with the use of three acres of land adjoining to the same during her life. Item I give & bequeath to my son William Hackett half a farm lot bounded as follows to wit. Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my good friends Mr William Hackett and Capt Nathl^l Partridge to be my jointly & severally Executors of this my last will & testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year first above written. Signed sealed published & declared in presence of Rob^t Brewton John Fraser John Ballantine

In the Name of God Amen I John Whitman of the County of Ballston County Plautis being weak of body & of perfect mind & memory I give & bequeath therefore to Almighty God do make for & leave this my present last will & testament in manner & forme following (that is to say) as touching the disposition of all such temporal Estate as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I give & bequeath thereof as followeth. First I will that my debts and funeral charges shall be paid & discharged. Item I give & bequeath to my loving son John two tracts of land on Clinton Island one containing five hundred acres & the other one hundred and also three tracts of land now leased out of Ashpoos River one containing three hundred acres of land one containing two hundred one containing two hundred twenty. Item I give & bequeath to my loving daughter Edith two tracts of land on a branch of Ashpoos River one containing one hundred acres & is known by the name of Turkey Hall & the other containing one hundred & fifty eight acres known by the name of
