by y^e same as Sachcovell her faithful Servants & appraisement thereof by
you made under y^e hands & upon y^e Oaths you returne in y^e before y^e Office
within ninety days next after y^e date hereof. I am under my hand & seal
this nineteenth day of January 1693.

Extracted from Original Record page 37th removed from Secretary of State's Office pursuant to
Act of General Assembly No. 1693 and examined by Mr. Hollenderichall by Order A.D. 1857.

November 15th 1692. I, Robert Bishop now make & doe through y^e
perfect memory & right remembrance doe and say unto my Soul to God
Almighty my body to y^e earth from whence I came & returne. I have long
daughter Mary Bishop of inicharn, my house & y^e whole buildings there
lie in at Carr & Smith Hall there is no man y^e can say he
had half things there was. I have a wife & son & daughter & son I
gave to William & one of his sons & one of his daughters & a boy. She stode in
young woman & had a son & a daughter & a boy about sixteen
months old. One more the son of a son & a daughter & a son. James &
he delivered a son three years & a half to a son of a son & a son & a son & a son.
Child one hour about sixteen we have a goodly number now and to hand
y^e. I have forgot of it may be greater number than is my remembrance. Mary

At: y^e tenth day of December 1692. I, R. Bishop aforesaid before me geatly
subscribed witnesses Francis Lampet, James Elmes ten chm. oakes dead de-
clare they were present & heard me y^e aforesaid speak some of whom will
& declare y^e same to be their last will & testam^t I was in sound mind & memory of
his doings by y^e best of their knowldege.

On ye 21st March 1693. Letter of Attorneys & Esq^r of Robt Bishop dead with
his will annexed were granted to Thomas Elmes Planter by the Gov^r:
Philipp Ludewall Governor of ye Province of Carolina.

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In the Name of God Amens. I, Joshua Hobson late
being sick & weaker of body but of sound perfecte mind memory blessed be
God for y^e same do make & ordaine this my last will & testament in y^e manner
& forme following (vizt) First & principally I give & devise the quietus of my
body to y^e Earth to be decently buried by my Execut^{or} hereafter nominated
all the rest of my goods, Chattels lands & tenments I give to my loving wife
Margaret to her her heirs forever. And lastly affay goods
Chattels lands & tenments belonging to me in England I equally give
devise and bequeath to my two brothers in England and mother Mr.
Paul Hobson & Mr. John Hobson and my mother Mrs. Mary Hobson
In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and
Seale this Seaventeenth day of July A.D. 1693. The year of

vizt. First I bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my maker
hoping through y^e meritorious death and passion of Jesus Christ my only
Saviour and redeemer to receive free pardon and forgiveness of all my sinnes
and as for my body let be buried in Christian burial at the discretion of my
Execut^{or} hereafter nominated. I leave all my houses lands and goods &
Chattels whatsoever that now is or hereafter shall be her or elsewhere I
give unto either my wife and her heirs forever, she paying all my debts
I make her sole Execut^{or} of this my last will and testam^t revoking
