Carolina p In the Name of God Amen The twenty first day of July on thousand six hundred and ninety one I Margaret Sackwell of Edistoew Island in Colleton County in the Province of Carolina widow being sick of body but of perfect remembrance pressed be God do make and ordaine this my last will & testament in manner & forme following viz: first I bequeath my soule into the hands of Almighty God my maker, hoping that through y^e merits of death & passion of Jesus Christ my only Saviour and Redeemer to receive his pardon and forgiveness of all my sins: as for my body to be buried at y^e discretion of my Executors hereafter nominated. Item I give unto my son David Sackwell y^e sum of fifteen pound sterl: all my little begets houses hold goods viz bedding linen pott Kettles plates & wearing apparell and rings. But if sh^{ould} happen that y^e John Sackwell should dye before he arrives to twenty on years of age my will is that it sh^{ould} be for the use & benefit of the roofes of my Executor hereafter named his father his heirs & assigns. Item All y^e rest of my houses lands goods & chattes I doe give & bequeath to my son in Law Thomas Sackwell and make ye sole he^{ir} of this my last will & testament.
