It is my mind & Will and I do hereby ordene and appoint that my Executors hereinafter named and y: survivor^{es} of them within ten days after my decease or soon after as may be to sell convey & dispose off to y: highest bidder and his heirs and assigns forever all and every my lands tenements moneys and hereditaments within this Province to be paid in Rece y: one half the net crop after my decease & y: other half y: crop ensuing. Item I give and bequeath all such sum and sums of money as shall arise by sale of my lands and hereditaments as aforesaid and all and singular my whole personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever unto my loving wife Mary Pasquereau & my loving son and daughter John and Mary Magdalene their Execs and Admrs forever equally to be divided between them share & share alike. Item my mind and will is that my said Execs do remitt and send y: produce of all my whole Estate both real & personalall unto y: said Alard Belin upon y: proper account and risque of my said wife & son and daughter. Item. It is my mind twill that my said wife removes with her self and her said two children from St Thomas's to St Christopher's and there resides at them and not return agen to St Thomas's and in mind and willis that in case of her sepa rate or neglecting to do upon notice of this my desire by my Execs or y: s: Alard Belin then her part and interest of

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Estate herein before given and bequeathed to her shall go to and belongs to my said son and daughter equally to be divided between them share and share alike and of a general devise thereof is hereby in such case declared void as to her. And I do hereby make and constitute myt H'rs: Ralph Izard & Benjamin De La Conciellure full and sole Ex'c't of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former and otherwells by me at any time heretofore made and do publish and declare this to be and stand as my last will and testament.
