Extracted from Original Record No. 4 June 27th, 1879, concerning an Order of the State of Ohio pursuant to act of said Senate, No. 1849, approved by the Senate on the 24th of May, 1879.

In the Name of God Amen I Joseph Swartz of the Island of St. John's
Nebuch considering of frailty of human life to make this my last will &
Testament in manner and form following. I Joseph Swartz give and bequeath
unto my dear and loving wife Margaret Swartz my negro woman called
Black Nell and her two sons Dick and Joshua and all other children
she shall happen to have at y^e time of my decease or y^e choice of any other
negro woman in my plantation in St. John in case she shall like any better
than Black Nell. I then charged with and subject to a proportionable
share of y^e payment of y^e legacies I request in and by this my will given and
bequeathed I give devise and bequeath unto my 2^d wife one moiety or equal

half part of ² use profits & produce of my plantation, negro household goods & whole estate real and personal to have & enjoy the same during her whole life full satisfaction of any dowry third or other claim ² she may have or be entitled unto out of my estate and in case my said wife shall marry again after my decease I give and bequeath unto her one third part only of ² use profits & produce of my ² estate during her life and ² D. third part I will take in like manner full of any dowry third or demands ² she may be any times entitled to out of my estate. Item. I give unto my two daughters Margaret & Mary Scoville the sum of three hundred pounds money of heris apiece, or fifty thousand pounds weight of sugar apiece to be paid or delivered unto them at their respective ages of eighteen years ² said two last mentioned legacies or portions given to my said daughters my will and mind is shall be raised out of ² profits of my said plantation and the stock thereon Also I will and desire that my ² two daughters shall be maintained and educated out of ² profits of my ² plantation untill they shall be married and in case my said daughters or either of them shall happen to depart this life before they shall respectively attain their ² ages of eighteen years my will and mind is that the legacy or portion given to her who shall dye shall go and remain in ² benefit of those who come I have bequeathed my said plantation Alse. I give and bequeath unto each of my said daughters one negro girl about fourteen years of age to be delivered to each of my said daughters by my Execut^{rs} on ² respective days of their marriages. I have given unto my two sons Philip & George Smith the heirs Execut^{rs} & Administrat^{rs} all my plantation negroes stock household goods real & other my real and personal estate & soever in the ² Island of Woods or elsewhere except what is above by this my will given to my wife and daughters And I do hereby make & constitute my ² last & sole Execut^{rs} of this my will And in case either of my ² sons should happen to depart this life without issue of his body my will and mind is that ² part share of my ² real and personal estate given & bequeathed to him so ² give shall go and remain to the ² issue of my said son's heirs Execut^{rs} and Administrat^{rs} and in case both my ² sons shall happen to depart this life without issue then my will and mind is that all such part of my real & personal estate as is by this my will given & bequeathed to my said two sons shall go and remain to my said two daughters their heirs Execut^{rs} & Administrat^{rs}. Item. I do hereby nominate & appoint my ² dear loving wife and my well beloved friends Capt William Mead & Mr Henry Burdett Mr James Brown to be Executors of my ² four children untill they shall attain their age of one & twenty years & be as Execut^{rs} of this my last will in Trust for my ² two sons during their minority and I do give unto ² D. brother one Beaver hat to each of them in case they shall act in the said ² D. hat for their care and pains therein. Item. I do hereby annul & make void all former and other will and wills by me at any time ~~heretofore~~ made and do make and constitute this to be my last will & testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seal this seventeenth day of December Anno ² 1699 and in the eighth year of ² reign of King William the third over England &c.
