

L. L. No 32. The last will and testament of Sarah Brumack, Single L. to 32
 Sarah Brumack of the County of Berks, Province of South Carolina
 widow being in perfect health and of sound judgment & memory thanks to God
 for it do make this my last will & testament in form & manner following. I give
 & bequeath my soul to God trusting this my last & lastation for the pardon of
 all my sins and a gracious acceptance with himself at the last day and
 my body to the earth to be decently buried by Mr Hugh West whom I appoint my
 Executor of this my will & wishing all other formerly by me made last &
 portion of goods which is hath pleased my heavenly father to grant me & dispense
 of as follows. 1 I ordain all my just debts to be paid. 2 I do bequeath unto
 Margaret Clapp five hundred pounds & two negroes vizt Wallington &
 Mattheus as also Mr Brumacks silver seal with the coat of Arms of his
 family on it my gold Buckle the cash & other children Elizabeth and Mary
 I do bequeath five hundred pounds. Which is to happen that one or the
 said children should dye before the payment of the said five hundred
 pounds then in that case my will is that the survivor should inherit
 (with her own) the five hundred pounds of the deceased & should they
 both dye I appoint her the said Margaret Clapp to inherit what I
 have to each of her children left. 3 I bequeath to my sister
 Boon during her natural life my bed chamber with its furniture and
 my wearing apparel & the attendance of Flora. 4 I bequeath to a
 dissenting Pastor or Preacher and his successors in that Office forever
 on the week) and to be settled on a tract of land lately purchased from
 Mr John Hales by deed of gift given to him & thow forever for ever for
 that use) One hundred pounds per annum for twenty years. I then to
 him the said dissenting Pastor or Preacher his successors forever I do
 bequeath

bequeath to three negroes Ann & Kate & one woman Kate bought of John
 Stead. to him and thow forever I do bequeath my silver tankard & the
 Cape. 5 I bequeath unto Thos Husanna Boon children of my nephew Thos
 Boon five hundred pounds each & should one die before the payment
 of the said five hundred pounds the survivor I appoint to inherit the
 five hundred pounds of the deceased & should both dye my will is that
 the father should inherit the entire thousand pounds. 6 I bequeath to
 Elizabeth Radcl daughter to my niece Susanna Radcl five hundred
 pounds & she should die before the payment of the said five hundred pounds
 I appoint the said Susanna Radcl heir to her daughter
 7 I bequeath unto John Hooper two hundred pounds & should he dye before
 the payment of the said two hundred pounds I appoint Thos Boon Junr
 son to my nephew Thomas Boon Junr to inherit the said two hundred
 pounds. 8 I bequeath to Thomas Tothall son of my niece Martha
 Hooper five hundred pounds. I then to Michael Beresford five
 hundred pounds and should either of them dye before the payment
 of his five hundred pound I appoint the survivor of them to inherit
 the five hundred pounds of the deceased and if both dye I appoint
 Sarah & Beth Junr to inherit the thousand pounds that I left to them.
 9 I bequeath to my sister Mary Melling all my child & one morning
 ring. 10 I bequeath unto Henry Livingston four three negro children
 vizt Dorey Cyrus & Lucy. 11 I do bequeath to the dissenting Pastor
 or Teacher of Churchway twenty pounds per annum for twenty years to the
 dissenting Pastor or Teacher at Service I bequeath to them per annu
 for twenty years. 12 I ordain that One thousand pounds be paid to be left
 John Vanderhorst and Capt Anthony Matthews Junr whose I appoint
 my trustees for the disposing of the said thousand pounds to such puse
 uses as I have signified to them. 13 I appoint my negro man Jack his
 freedom upon this condition that he pay five pounds current money yearly
 to the dissenting Pastor or teacher on the week. I then I appoint Mr
 Indy her freedom on condition she pay to said dissenting Teacher yearly
 five shillings. 14 I bequeath all the rest of my estate real & personal
 unto Mr Hugh West he paying the above mentioned legacies with all
 costs & out expenses according to the present value or currency of money
 and at his death I appoint & ordain that the one entire half of my said
 estate real and personal shall descend to my niece Sarah West &
 her heirs forever & the other half to be disposed of at the pleasure of him
 the said Hugh West. This I publish & declare to be my last will &
 testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
 this 26th day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred
 & twenty six in the presence of - Memorandum that before the signing
 sealing & witnessing of this my will the words Hearest Freedom was said
