all my debts funeral charges and the aforesaid legacy be paid all the
rest residue of my estate both real and personall whither lands
goods chattels rights credits or Interest whatsoever and to herby
nominate constitute ordain & appoint my P^r loving wife Esther my
full sole Executrix of this my will hereby revoking all former written
will by me made & declare this be my only will. In witness whereof
