Thomas Greatbeach

In the Name of God Amos the twenty eighth day of November in
the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred ninety & seven. I Thomas
Greatbeach of the Province of Carolina being at present of sound and
perfect memory God be praised for it, And being desirous to settle
affaires in this world doe make and ordaine this my last will and testa-
ment in manner and forme following that is to say, first and principally
Commending my soule to Almighty God my maker and Redeemer assuredly
trusting that I shall receive full pardon & free remission of all my sin-
nes and be saved by the precious death & meritts of my Saviour Jesus Christ
in whom only where I trust to be saved & redeemed And my body raised againe
at the day of the Generall resurrection and placed amongst the blessed saints
in Heaven. My body I commit to the Earth whereof I came to be buried
according to Christian buriall at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
named and as touching such worldly Estate as the Lord in mercy
hath sent me my will and meaning is that the same shall be employ-
ed and bestowed as hereafter in this my will is expressed: And first
I doe revoke revoke frustrate and make void all wills by me for-
merly made and doe declare and appoint this my last will and testament.
I doe will and ordaine that all those debts & duties as I doe owe
of right a conscience to any manner of person or persons whatsoever
shall be well and truly paid and payed or ordained to be paid
within convenient time after my decease and without any trouble
by my Executors hereafter named. I doe give & bequeath to my
sonne Daniell Greatbeach all my land or lands house or houses
that doth properly belong to me in Carolina or elsewhere to witte all
my wearing clothes all my silver buckles & buttons with the two
gold rings I commonly did wear in my lifetime. I doe likewise
give and bequeath unto my sonne Daniell aforesaid all my stock
of sheepe, excepting those that in this my will is hereafter given
& bequeathed. I doe also give and bequeath unto my said sonne
Daniell Greatbeach the moiety or halfe part of (all my stock of)
cattle of cow & cow kine and also the moiety or halfe part of
all my stock of swine Likewise my best gun being a fuzee with
boynt & Catnach top sword & pistoll and likewise I doe give &
bequeath unto my sonne Daniell Greatbeach the moiety or halfe
part of all my household stuffe as pewter brass iron &c.
