in the Province of South Carolina and wife of Colonel Nathaniel Haskett have drawn
three Bills of Exchange all of one tenour and bearing even date with the
present all one and twenty day eight on the said Elizabeth Haskett my husband
in London for the full and just sum of twenty pounds sterling payable to James Butler
of Charles Towne in the said Province of South Carolina Merchant or his order the said
James Butler having paid to me the said Elizabeth Haskett the full sum of
seven pounds ten shillings current Moneys of South Carolina being for the
Value of the said Bills of Exchange and Whereas the said Elizabeth Haskett
drawn three other Bills of Exchange all of one tenour and bearing even date
these presents at one and twenty day eight on the said Elizabeth Haskett my husband
in London for the full and just sum of ten pounds sterling payable to the said
James Butler or his order, the said James Butler having paid to me of the said
Elizabeth Haskett the full sum of twelve pounds ten shillings current Money
of South Carolina for the value of the said Bills of Exchange and Whereas
the said James Butler at the special Instance and request of me the said Elizabeth
Haskett hath entered himself security in the Secretarys office of this Province
of South Carolina for me the said Elizabeth Haskett & for John Cogsett of this Province
and for Charles MacCarthy servants to me the said Elizabeth Haskett in the sum
of one thousand pounds each in order to the taking out mine and their several
Tickets and they being all bound of this Province for the Kingdom of England
mine nor their names not being published such sufficient time as is required
of laws and Customs of this Place now know ye that for the better security
of the said several Bills of Exchange being Accepted and paid and for the
better and more effectual securing and saving harmless and keeping
undempnified him the said James Butler his heirs Executors and Administrators
from all damage Cost and trouble that may arise upon the account of the
said James Butler entering himself security in the said Secretarys office
aforesaid. the said Elizabeth Haskett Have Bargained sold and Delivered
these presents in due forme of Law Doe Bargaine sell and Deliver unto the said
James Butler one negroe woman named Jany Three negroe boys named Tommy
Nanipus and Carolina and Three negroe girls named Nellie moll and Mary
and a parcell of plate weighing one hundred forty four ounces TO HAVE
And to hold the said Bargained premises unto the said James Butler

His Executors administrators and assigns to the only proper use and behoof
of the said James Butler his Executors administrators and assigns for ever
and the said Elizabeth Haskett for my self my Executors and Administrators
the said Bargained premises unto the said James Butler his Executors administrators
assignes against all persons shall and will warrant and for ever defend by them presents
is Provided nevertheless that if one of the above mentioned Bills of Exchange
for seventy pounds sterling shall be accepted and duly paid according to the
tenour and Effect of the same or in Case of failure of the acceptance or the
payment thereof if then the said Elizabeth Haskett my Executors administrators
or assigns shall on or before the ninth day of March next following the
date hereof pay or cause to be paid to the said James Butler his Executors admini-
strators or assigns in South Carolina the said sum of Eighty seven pounds
ten shillings being the Value received of the said James Butler for the said Bills of Exchange
as aforesaid Together with all the charges of Protests and all other charges whatsoever
relating to the same and Lawfull Interest for the said sum of Eighty seven pounds
ten shillings at the rate of ten per Cent: to be Computed from the day of the date
of these presents untill the time of repayment and if one of the above mentioned
Bills of Exchange for Ten pounds sterling shall be accepted and duly paid accord-
ing to the tenour and Effect of the same or in Case of failure of the acceptance
or the payment thereof if then the said Elizabeth Haskett my Executors adminis-
trators or assigns shall on or before the said ninth day of March next fol-
lowing the date hereof pay or cause to be paid to the said James Butler his Ex-
ecutors Administrators or assigns in South Carolina the said sum of Twelve
pounds ten shillings being the value received of the said James Butler for the said
Bills of Exchange as aforesaid Together with all the charges of Protests and all other
charges whatsoever relating to the same and Lawfull Interest for the said sum of
twelve pounds ten shillings at the rate of ten per Cent: to be Computed from the
day of the date of these presents untill the time of repayment AND shall also save
harmless and Keep undempnified the said James Butler his heirs Executors
and administrators of from all action suits Costs Charges Judgements
Executions and Demands whatsoever which may happen upon the account
of the said James Butler entering himself security in the said Secretarys office in
South Carolina as aforesaid then this present Bill of sale to be void or else to remain
in full force & vertue In witness whereof the said Elizabeth Haskett
have hereunto set my hand and seal the ninth day of June in the year of our

and prosecute for the same; and upon such suit to proceed to Judgment and
Execution and thereupon the body and bodies of such person and persons in
prison to Cast hold detaine and keep untill full satisfaction be made
together with all Costs and Charges sustained or to be sustained therein of
there abouts and upon paymt thereof such person or persons forth of Prison
to discharge and set at liberty; and to Compound Conclude and agree
quitances or other sufficient Discharges for me and in my name to make
seal and deliver and General to doe & performe all and Every such
further & other act & acts thing & things as shall be needfull and necessary to
be done in the premises ab fully and effectually as my selfe might or
could doe if personally present Ratifying and holding for good and
Effectually all and what soever my said attorneys shall see in the p^{re}s
jointly or severally by virtue of these presents & Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal y^e twenty Eight day of July in y^e year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and two;
