To all to whom these presents shall come I Elizabeth Haskett now resident in South Carolina an wife of Coloneill Haskett Governor of the late colony in Georgia Island and Planting Whereas the said Elizabeth Haskett have due her Bill of Exchange all of one Tenour and bearing even date with the present at one and twenty days sight on the said Elizabeth Haskett my husband in London for a full and just sume of Twenty pounds Sterling payable to James Butler of Charleston in the said Province of South Carolina Merchant or his order the said James Butler having paid to me the said Elizabeth Haskett a full sum of seven pounds ten Shilling Current Money of South Carolina being for a Value of the said Bills of Exchange AND Whereas by the said Elizabeth Haskett drawn three other Bills of Exchange all of one tenour and bearing even date these presents at one and twenty day sight on the said Elizabeth Haskett my husband in London for a full and just sume of ten pounds Sterling payable all due to the said James Butler or his order the said James Butler having paid to me the said Elizabeth Haskett the full sume of twelve pounds ten Shillings currant Money of South Carolina for a value of the said Bills of Exchange AND Whereas by the said James Butler at a speciall instance and request of me of the said Elizabeth Haskett hath entered himselfe security in the secretarys office of this Province of South Carolina for me of the said Elizabeth Haskett to pay John Doggett of this Regiment and Mr Charles Maccharthy servants to me of the said Elizabeth Haskett in the sume of one thousand pounds each in order to taking out mine and their several Tickets and they being all bound of this Province for the Kingdom of England mine nor their values not being publisht such sufficient time as is required by Lawe and Customs of this place NOW KNOW YEL that for a better secure the said severall Bills of Exchange being Accepted and paid and for the better and more effectuall securing and saving harmless and keeping indemnified him of the said James Butler his heirs Executors and Administrators from all damage Cost and trouble that may arise upon his account of the said James Butler entering himselfe security in the said secretarys office aforesaid by the said Elizabeth Haskett Have Bargained sold and delivered these presents in due forme of Lawe doo Bargaine sell and deliver unto the said James Butler one negro woman named Lucy Three negro boys named Tom, Noris, and Carolina and Three negro girls named Nelly, moll, and Clara and a parcell of plate weighing one hundred forty four Ounces TO HAVE AND TO HOLD of the said Bargained price unto the said James Butler

His Executors administrators and assigns to his only proper yse and behayf of the said James Butler his Executors administrators and assigns for ever and I the said Elizabeth Haskett for my selfe my Executors and administrators the said Bargained price unto the said James Butler his Executors administrators and assigns against all persons shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents PROVIDED nevertheless that if one of the above mentioned Bills of Exchange for Seventy pounds Sterling shall be accepted and duly paid according to the tenour and effect of the same or in case of failure of the acceptance or the payment thereof of them by the said Elizabeth Haskett my Executors administrators or assigns shall on or before the ninth day of March next ensuing the date hereof pay or cause to be paid to the said James Butler his Executors administrators or assigns in South Carolina the sume of Eighty seven pounds ten Shillings being a value received of the said James Butler for the said Bills of Exchange as aforesaid Together with all the charges of Protests and all other charges whatsoever relating to the same and Lawfull Interest for the sume of Eighty seven pounds ten Shillings at the rate of ten per Cent: to be computed from the day of the date of these presents until the time of repayment AND if one of the above mentioned Bills of Exchange for Ten pounds Sterling shall be accepted and duly paid according to the tenour and effect of the same or in case of failure of the acceptance or the payment thereof of them by the said Elizabeth Haskett my Executors administrators or assigns shall on or before the ninth day of March next ensuing the date hereof pay or cause to be paid to the said James Butler his Executors administrators or assigns in South Carolina the sume of Twelve pounds ten Shillings being a value received of the said James Butler for the said Bills of Exchange as aforesaid Together with all the charges of Protests and all other charges whatsoever relating to the same and Lawfull Interest for the sume of twelve pounds ten Shillings at the rate of ten per Cent: to be computed from the day of the date of these presents until the time of Prepayment AND shall also save harmless and keep indemnified of the said James Butler his heirs Executors and Administrators of him from all action suits Costs Charges Judgments Executions and Demands whatsoever which may happen upon his account of the said James Butler entering himselfe security in the secretarys office in Carolina as aforesaid then this present Bill of sale to be void or else to remain in full force & vertue In witness whereof the said Elizabeth Haskett have hereunto sett my hand and seal the ninth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and two Elizabeth Haskett

at Carolina now Rector of the Parish of St. Thomas in the Island of Jamaica  
have made ordaine Constituted & appointed and doth in and by these  
presents make ordaine Constitute and appoint Henry Wigington of  
Charles town in south Carolina Practitioner att Law and William  
Shaw of Port Royal in the Island of Jamaica mariner my true and  
lawfull attorney or attorneys soynly and severally for me in my name  
and to my use to ask Demand sue for lvy require recover and receive  
of from all and Every person and persons whatsoever in Carolina all sum  
& suites of money as now are or hereafter shall be due owing  
as belonging to me by any manner of ways or means whatsoe  
ever upon non paymt thereof or of any part thereof such person or per-

son refusing to pay the same for me and in my name to sue arrest garnis-  
hee and prepete for the same; and upon such suit to proceed to Judgment and  
Execution and thereupon the body and bodys of such person and persons in  
prison to Cast hold letaine and keep untill full satisfaction be made  
together with all Costs and Charges sustained or to be sustained therein up-  
there abouts and upon paymt hereof such person or persons forth of Prison  
to discharge and set at liberty; and to Compound Conclude and agree  
quitances or other sufficient discharge for me and in my name to make  
Leale and deliver and Generall to doe & performe all and Every such  
further & other act & acts thing & things as shall be needfull and necessary to  
be done in the premises as fully and effectually as my selfe might or  
could doe if personally present & affyng and holding for good and  
Effectually all and what soever my said attorney shall see in the premises  
soynly or severally by virtue of these presents I witness whereof I have  
hereunto sett my hand and seal & twenty Eight day of July in & year of our  
Lord one thousand seaven hundred and two.
