Five Barrels of Beef & five Stubs of Butter, marked
A P M i to 9. & i to 5. And shipped on board the Sloop Sea flower
Capt John Flavell Comander. And consigned to the said Marmaduke
Froomean, And he the said Marmaduke Froomean doth truly give
a just Accomp^t of said Beef & Butter. And render y^e effects
thereof to the said Warren or any person Imponured by him to
receive the same. Then this obligation is to be void And of no

your hundred & fiftie pounds Sterl, payed to say Abraham Harris
or his assignes the foresaid Receipt being signed over to me for
my use & it is to say your hundred pounds Sterl of said Bond
paid also a Bond under the hand & Seal of the said Abraham
Harris bearing Date even with these presents payable to me or
my assignes for the sume of Eight hundred pounds Sterl which is
for the performance of the foresaid engagement, that the said
hundred pounds first be paid unto the said Warren or order
by the Island of Jamaica. Now I do promise unto the said
Abraham Harris that if in Case I do not receive the said sum
of your hundred pounds of the aforesaid offerman or his decessor
will deliver unto him the said Abraham Harris the aforesaid receipt
of the aforesaid offerman bearing Date the 1st of August last 1694.
