 on board and do their utmost Endeavour to forward and
 promote the good designs and Interest of the Voyage for load-
 ing for Week a Week working thereon getting and buying
 of Bales for Cyle and all other comfort and necessary things
 to be done the Voyage under the said Governor's and
 Command of y^e said William Fisher who of the parties
 have hereunto set their hands and Seals this 11th Day
 of April Anno 1701 James One Thousand and
