I know all men by those presents y<sup>r</sup> no Ann Hayman Samuel Hargrave Clinton all of the parish of St. Peters in the Island of Barbados Attorneys to James Hayman Esq<sup>r</sup> as by power acknowledged and recorded both more fully appear doth constitute & appoint Mr. John Bonnington of Carolina Govt as true & lawfull attorney to and for us all & all manner of debts rents, sum or sums of monies or heraffter to be due or payable to y<sup>r</sup> James Hayman by any person whomsover or by any manner cause or thing if y<sup>r</sup> James Hayman to make & give acquittances or otherwise to stand of y<sup>r</sup> James Hayman to enter or make any entry Belonging or in anywise appertaining or any other lands tenement or hereditam<sup>s</sup> unto y<sup>r</sup> James Hayman by reason of the non payment of any rent or rents sum or sum or leases conveantes or otherwise howsoever & for us & our names or in y<sup>r</sup> name or to y<sup>r</sup> right of y<sup>r</sup> James Hayman to recover & to take all or any rents issued or profits of all or any such lands tenements or hereditaments, and in our name or in y<sup>r</sup> name of y<sup>r</sup> James Hayman to come or prosecute any suit or suits action or actions as well real as personal or mixt for any debt dues matter causes or things whatsoever due or belonging to y<sup>r</sup> James Hayman or to be demanded or y<sup>r</sup> may be demanded in any court or courts of record or in any other court or place whatsoever by y<sup>r</sup> James Hayman or suits or executors of them to prosecute & follow or discontinued y<sup>r</sup> James
