Know all men by these presents that I Anthony Cordes of y^e said Province of Guyana have remised released for ever quitted claim and by these presents do for me my heirs Executors & Administrators Remise release and forever quit claim unto Thomas Founds of y^e Province aforesaid his heirs Executors & Administrators all and all manner of actions cause and causes of Actions Suits bills Bonds writings Obligations Mortgages Debts accounts Sum and Sums of money Judgments Executions Exports quarrels controversies trespasses damages and demands whatsoever both in law and Equity w^h against y^e said Thomas Founds I ever had now have or w^h I my heirs Executors & Administrators shall or may have claims challenges or demands for or by reason colour or means of any matter cause of thing from y^e beginning of y^e world to y^e day of the date of these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seale y^e thirtieth day of May anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and two
