& Lawfull Attorney, Executors, & Administrators. to y^e which Payment
Well & truly to be made we bind our selves & either of us by himself
Jointly & severally for y^e whole & in y^e whole, our & every of our heirs
Executors, & Administrators. every of them firmly by these Presents
without Seal Dated y^e 3. Day of July Anno Domini 1700.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above named
James Stewart, William Miller, Thomas Flower & John May or either
of them their ^{executors} or their heirs, Executors, & Administrators. shall
Do well & truly pay or cause to be paid to y^e above named Dove
Williamson his Executors, Administrators, or Assignes y^e full Sum of twenty
Pounds, five Shill & seven Pence Sterl. to be paid in England or else
where without fraud or further Delay. That then this Obligation
to be void & of no Effect or else to be & remain in full force & virtue

house & out house & all manner of Buildings Edifices & appurtenances to y^e
said house & Plantation, situate, standing, being with all fences Timber & under
woods & under woods now standing lying & growing on y^e said Land & Plantation y^e
to have hold, occupy, Possess & Enjoy, For & during y^e full Term & Space of
seven years & a half, from y^e date hereof, without any Lett, hindrance or
Molestation whatsoever by from or under me or any other Person or Persons
whatsoever & y^e said James Basford for & on his Behalf doth hereby
grant, Promise & agree to pay or cause to be paid unto y^e said Anthony
Mathews his certain attorney heirs or assignes y^e yearly or Annual
Rent of fifteen Pounds Sterl. Money of y^e said Province of Annam
upon that it to lay y^e sum of fifteen Pound at or upon y^e 29. day of June next
ensuing, Leaven teen Hundred & one & so at y^e Expiration of every years
during y^e said Lease, without faile, & doth further Covenant, Promise
agree, & keep y^e said house, Edifices & Buildings in good Tree & reasonable
repair & y^e fencing defensive as now at y^e delivery hereof they are
at y^e Expiration of y^e Term & Time of this Lease to deliver up unto
y^e said Anthony Mathews, his certain attorney heirs or assignes y^e said
Plantation with y^e houses buildings & fencing in such like repair
as in as good condition as they now stand & be at signing of this pre
Lease & Indenture, fire & Enemys excepted which by Casualty
shall happen, And for y^e well due & true Performance hereof and
Party to y^e other Do hereby Oblige themselves their heirs Executors
& Administrators each to y^e other in y^e full & just sum of one hundred
pounds like Curr. Money of Carolina, to be paid in Default hereof by
