 hundred & thirteen casks of Rum, Eleven Bags of Sealed Ginger
 thirteen Boxes of small Lead Shot, Eight Hamakers one Box of Medi-
 cines three Negroes & one Cask of Rum and for y^e Catharine
 Dubois y^e Value or Proceed of five Negroes also laden in y^e said
 Ship upon Receipt to give acquittances & othe sufficient dis-
 charges in due forme & in Case of refusal or Delay of Payment
 to use all lawfull waies & means to Attach, Imprison in Prison
 to hold & to discharge and Generally in & about y^e Premises
 to do all & whatsoever shall be requisite as fully as y^e Con-
 stituents themselves might or could do if P^resent. With power
 to substitute one or more attorney with like or limited power
 & y^e same again to Revok. The P^resent Constituents promising
 severally to hold for good & valid all & whatsoever shall be
 lawfully done in & about y^e Premises by Virtue of these
 P^resents In Witness whereof they have hereunto put their

 Whereas William Earle of Raven Palatine is
 y^e last of y^e true and absolute Lords & Proprietors of y^e Province of North
 Carolina under y^e Great Seal appointed for y^e Purpose & under
 hand of Paul Gumball Esq^r Chief Justice & y^e rest of y^e Justices for
 conveying Lands in Carolina, Bearing date y^e Seventh & twentieth
 day of July Anno Dⁿⁱ one thousand six hundred Ninety & two, I do
 Grant unto me y^e Edward Loughton one Sonn Lot in Charles
 Towne siting in y^e West End of y^e Towne upon record in y^e
 Surveyor Gen^l Office by y^e Number Eighty one in B^utings & bound
 to y^e Edward upon a Lot laid out to Peter Horn, to y^e Westward
 on a Lot laid out to John Thoroughgood to y^e Northward upon a Lot of John
 Stevens deced^t & to y^e Southward on a Lot in y^e Possession of y^e heirs
 George Pawley dec^d. I have made to hold y^e said Lot to me y^e
 Edward Loughton my heirs & assigns for ever, Yeild^t & pay
 111th therefore yearly every year unto y^e Palatine & his heirs & assigns
 after y^e rate of one Penny of lawfull Money of England
 or y^e same quantity of Silver in Bullion or other Coin as there is or
 Law ought to be on one penny of lawfull money of the said
 Deed or Grant & all other things therein had & may more fully
