

To all People to whom this present Writing shall Come Wee Benjamin Nicoll John Rose Patrick Walsh & Giles Been of London Merchants Greeting — Whereas the Ship called of Col & Bur Gallo was about 2 month of August anno 1695 One thousand six hundred ninety & nine fifties out by us said Benjamin Nicoll John Rose Patrick Walsh & Giles Been freighted with sundry Goods & merchandises mentioned in 2 Indict & Bill of Lading therewith with her bound for 2 Islands of Corora & Encife & from thence to Peling And Whereas 2 Indict & Bills of Lading arriving at Carolina in 3 month of December then next following was there seized & condemned by Sentence of 2 Court of Admiralty held for said Province on Wednesday 23 day of January following on pretence of her Not having a Certificate of Register in form according to an Act of Parliament made in ye year of 25th year of his Majesties reign Entituled Anact for preventing frauds and regulating a Trade in Plantation Trade which Sentence was afterwards by Order of Council bearing date 23d of July anno 1695 made into a Report from 2d Lord & 2d Committee His Majesties most humble Servt for hearing appeals from 2 Indict & Bills of Lading therewithal of us if said Benjamin Nicoll John Rose Patrick Walsh & Giles Been from 2d Sentence reversed and set aside and all Spes therewon declared null & void You know well that wee if said Benjamin Nicoll John Rose Patrick Walsh & Giles Been for a sume of Especial Trust & Confidence which wee have da lepose in our loving friend James Butler London Merchants were made Intervenit Constituted & Appointed & to their presents to make, Ordain, Constitute & Appoint 2d James Butler our lawfull Attorney for us in minnes & to take use to us demand, leavy, sue for recover & receive of & from Elizabeth Blake of birth Carolina Wifte of Belis & Leavent, & Hugh Blake Esq late Lord of Carolina Edmund Bellinger of birth Carolina Esq Informer against us & Giles & Pevenally & Sir George Thomas Broughton Esq James Blake Esq his Majesties Collector of 2 Indict & Bills of said Province their either of their Law or Admirals And also all other Persons & Persons whatsoever full decompence & destitution & satisfaction by us to us Giles & Been & Co and her cargo, and all Debts, dues & demands, sum or sum of money whatsoever which are in any wise due owing or belonging to us & either of us from us said Elizabeth Blake, Edmund Bellinger, & Thomas Broughton their either of their Law or Admirals, or from any other Person or Persons whatsoever for or in respect thereof And Ilemit to us demand, leavy, sue for recover & receive all singular such other goods or merchandises Debts, dues & demands

sum or sum of money whatsoever which now are due or shall or may in any time appear to before rising Papaliam belonging to us if said Benjamin Nicoll John Rose, Patrick Walsh & Giles Been from any Person or Persons whatsoever upon Any Account whatsoever giving & by their presents granting unto our said Attorney our full & lawfull Authority for & touching the recovery & recovering of all & Benallies aforesaid to sue, Implead, prosecute, pursue, Searc, arrest, search, Impound, Confine or of Prison to deliver, and to compound & give Acquitt, release, & discharge, One attorney or more under him to substitute & make & agam at his pleasure the same to recouer, and further to do performe & execute all & every such other lawfull Act or Acts thing or things whatsoever which by 2d Law of the Kingdom of England or 2d Law of Province of Carolina may be lawfully done & performed which shall be meet needfull & expedient to be done in as large & ample manner as we our selves could do, if wee were personally present, or else in some personally — Reciting and for sume of Table holding all, whatsoever our said Attorney or any under him substituted shall lawfully do & execute acts in or touching 2d Indict & Bill of Lading whereof wee if said Benjamin Nicoll John Rose, Patrick Walsh & Giles Been have forint to set our handes, this 25th day of September anno 1695.
