and the same to sell and Dispose of according to his Discretion to my
best advantage, as alsoe for me and in my Name and to my use to
clerk Adams I do for Harry require recover and Receivd of and
from George Legan of the Province of Carolina all and every sum
and sumes of money Goods Merchandise Debts dues & Demands
which in any manner of way either in Law or Equity is due to me and in case
of Deniall or refusal to arrest my person and prosecute to judgment full
sentence Deed final Execution and satisfaction or if need be to referre
to Arbitration after any difference that shall be depending between
me and him or any other person or persons whatsoever videntes and
Discharges in my Name to make sale & deliver And Generally to Act in
all like things in all Cases as fully and Amply to all intents
and purposes as if the Constituant were personally present with
full power to my said Attorney to make one or more attorney or
attorneys under him and the same at his pleasure to Revoke
