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 Memorandum Some Time in the middle of August I arrived
 at St. Thomas where meeting with Samuell Bradley, Capt. Kidd's
 Brother-in-Law, and after being some time there, the Governor
 knowing I came from those parts Capt. Kidd came from and
 that I knew y^e ^{Gov^r} Bradley as a friend, belonged to y^e ^{Gov^r} Kidd's
 ship & told me severall questions concerning him. I told
 him I had been severall Times on Board y^e ^{Gov^r} Kidd's Ship
 in y^e Indies, where I saw y^e ^{Gov^r} Bradley extremely ill, and
 by Discourse of y^e ^{Gov^r} ^{Gov^r} had been so y^e most part of their
 Voyage, and y^e Deponent further saith, That when he saw
 him at St. Thomas he was in a worse condition than before
 and that y^e ^{Gov^r} Govern^r aforesaid told me that upon his being
 put on shore he brought him upon his Examination and that
 he could find nothing to Charge y^e ^{Gov^r} Bradley with, and that
 he was put on shore upon a Point three Miles from the
 Town without any Thing to assist him with, and with much
 Persecution gave him his Rest & Cloths. And further I
 heard y^e ^{Gov^r} Govern^r say that his bringing nothing a shore was
 him but his self & finding nothing to Charge him with by
 Examination, and believe him to be Innocent upon y^e ^{Gov^r} Charge
 him: The Deponent further saith, That there happened to me
 three English Men of War, whilft I y^e ^{Gov^r} Deponent was there
 and after some Discourse with y^e ^{Gov^r} Govern^r, I said if there
 had not been one Capt. Kidd off his Harbour, he told them
 that there had: Then they asked if he or any of his Men
 had been on shore, he told them had & that y^e ^{Gov^r} ^{Gov^r} ^{Gov^r}
 as aforesaid & 4 more who came Passengers in y^e ^{Gov^r} Ship
 from y^e Indies & that he had Examined them but particularly
 y^e ^{Gov^r} Bradley being Kidd's Brother, & could find nothing
 to Charge him or them with, & y^e ^{Gov^r} Deponent further saith
 That when he was on Board y^e ^{Gov^r} Ship as aforesaid he heard
 y^e ^{Gov^r} Ship's Company say, That y^e ^{Gov^r} ^{Gov^r} Bradley often Deposed
 of India, & further this Deponent saith that
 this Day personally appeared before me (Capt. Temple)
 Rogers & upon his Oath declared that y^e ^{Gov^r} ^{Gov^r}
 Relation or Deposition is true in y^e ^{Gov^r} ^{Gov^r} ^{Gov^r}
